

## Fixture Styles

### Traditional:



A traditional style has its origins in a specific historical period. Traditional fixtures are often modeled on actual period pieces; some may be close replicas. In other cases, distinctive historical design elements are used to communicate the feeling of the traditional style. Most traditional fixtures come in bronze or gold-toned finishes.

### Contemporary/Modern:



Contemporary/modern design suggests clean lines, forms that follow the intended function, and new materials. Many contemporary/modern fixtures come in a bronze or silver-toned finish.

### Transitional:



Transitional is not a specific style. Transitional fixtures are ones that are compatible with Traditional, Modern or Contemporary styles and furnishings.
